

Distinguished Educator Hall of Fame

PURPOSE:

- The Educator Hall of Fame has been established to honor and recognize the outstanding and memorable retired educators who significantly impacted and made a difference in the lives of their students and whose professional capability and integrity inspired the admiration and respect of not only students but fellow staff and the community.

CRITERIA

- Nominees must have made long-term contributions to student success
- Nominees must have maintained exemplary standards of behavior and ethics
- Nominees must have exhibited leadership in their work
- Nominees must have demonstrated competency in their subject matter
- Nominees must have left a lasting influence on the students they taught and on the Angleton Independent School District.

GUIDELINES:

- Nominees must be retired educators of the Angleton school district.
- Nominees may have worked at any campus, including Marshall.
- Nominees must have worked in education at least 20 years, with at least 10 in AISD.
- Nominees must meet the criteria for recognition as stated in the purpose.
- Nominees may be living or deceased.

NOMINATIONS:

- Nominations may be made by former students, fellow co-workers or members of the public.
- Multiple nominations will be accepted and considered for an educator.
- Nomination forms are available at the administration office, the Angleton School History Center, and the websites for Angleton ISD and the Angleton Alumni Association.

SELECTION COMMITTEE:

- Four Angleton Alumni Association board members
- One Marshall Alumni Board representative
- An alumni representative from the 1940s, 1950s, 1960s, 1970s, 1980s

Hall of Fame Selection Committee members will recuse themselves from the selection process if they have personal investments in nominees. All nominations will be reviewed and considered by this committee. Nominations will be kept on file for five years and will be reviewed and considered for induction for following years up to five years after their submission.

Three will be inducted each year. Not more than one should be deceased.

RECOGNITION:

- Inductees will be announced and honored at the AISD Employee banquet in May.
- Inductees will also be honored at a community reception.
- Photos and biographies of all inductees will be on permanent display at the Angleton School History Center.
